The annual Book Fair will be arriving at school on the week of Monday 11th November. There will be a wide variety of books to suit all ages and all interests. Every year, you the parents, have been very supportive of our Book Fair and we have been able to purchase many books for the school through the 40% discount the school receives back. Reminders for Parents:

- Did you know that our Breakfast Club offers a range of cereals, toast, pancakes, muffins and bagels? Our girls can also have beans and scrambled egg on different mornings. Club opens at 8am and costs only £1 (or 50p without breakfast). It is a great way to get the day started with activities and games organised by our team of friendly and experienced classroom assistants.
- As a Healthy Eating school, our Healthy Break Scheme continues this year. A snack and milk are available to all children in school at a cost of £2 per week or £10 for a 5 week block. However, children are free to bring their own healthy break to school but, please encourage your daughter to choose a healthy snack e.g. a piece of fruit, bread or yoghurt.
